

Pear Comprehensive Respiratory Educator Program

This program, developed by Pear Healthcare Solutions Inc. and available at healthlearning.ca, was created with the goal of helping pharmacists and other healthcare professionals qualify for, and prepare to challenge, the Canadian Network for Respiratory Care (CNRC) examination to achieve the Certified Respiratory Educator (CRE) credential. The Comprehensive Respiratory Educator Program consists of three programs: Comprehensive Asthma Program, Comprehensive COPD Program, and Foundational Health Education Program. The Canadian Council on Continuing Education in Pharmacy (CCCEP) has accredited these three programs for a total of 32.5 CEUs (continuing education units).

The program was developed in consideration of the CNRC National Learning Objectives for Respiratory Educators, and the content is matched to these competencies. Completing this program will not only confer eligibility to write the CNRC examination but will provide you with a **solid foundation** for success. Participants will learn and apply their knowledge through completion of brief online modules of approximately 30 to 45 minutes in length that include specific content, assessments, and quizzes. This program also includes the mandatory CNRC Foundational Health Education workbook.
